Please read prior to signing referral form

 information of their animal's condition, any other health issues and expected outcome of physiotherapy
 treatment.
- All animals must be up to date with their annual booster vaccinations. Proof of the same could be requested
 at any time.
- Animals with infectious diseases such as eye, skin, ear infections, vomiting or diarrhoea will not be treated for health and safety reasons.
 - It is recommended that all animals receive regular health checks with their Veterinarian to monitor the condition being treated with Aisling Delaney Animal Physiotherapy and ensure they are fit to continue with treatment.
- Owners must inform the practice if, during treatment, the animals condition worsens, if medication changes,
 or if the Veterinarian advises that the treatment be suspended.
- All sessions must be paid for in full on the day of treatment. If your animal is insured a detailed receipt will be
 issued to you to check your eligibility with your insurance company.
